


G206 conference room is equipped with a computer, projector, BluRay player, ScreenBeam, Polycom and A/V control system with sound. The projection surface can also be written on using a dry erase marker.

- The computer is located on a console in the rear of the room.
- If the computer screen is blank, move the mouse to wake it up. If it does not respond, press the power button located on lower right side of the computer.
- Log in by typing your network name and password.
- **REMEMBER TO LOG OUT WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED.**

The controls for the **projector power, volume** and **input source** are located on the wall to the left of the podium.

If you wish to connect other devices to the projector, use the **laptop cable** or **HDMI cable** on the table and press the corresponding button on the wall controller. Additional dongles for most laptops are attached to the **HDMI cable**.




Instructions using **ScreenBeam** to **wireless connect** your laptop to the projector are on the reverse side of these instructions. Select **Wireless** on the controller to use this option. The wireless keyboard and mouse can be moved to the conference table for your convenience.



Select **HDMI Table** on the controller when using the HDMI cable at the table. The cable marked **Laptop** is specifically for laptops with a DisplayPort connection.

There is also an HDMI cable connected to a floor box under the podium. Select **HDMI Podium** when using this cable.



Wireless Video Display

- Compatible Windows laptops (and Android devices) can display their video wirelessly using a device connected to the projector known as **ScreenBeam**.
- If you are unsure of whether you have a compatible Windows laptop, press the Windows Key and P to see if the projection menu appears.
- **ScreenBeam is not currently compatible with any Apple devices.**
- It will create a point-to-point connection between your device and the room display.


Power on the AV system using the wall mounted control panel.

Press the **WIRELESS** button




On your laptop, press the **Windows Key** and “**P**” to bring up Projection Options

Select:
Connect to a wireless display



Alternately, you can type “**Project**” in your search box.


Then select:
Project to a second screen.



From the connect list
Select: **G206-SB**

The first time you connect, **ScreenBeam** will display a code on the display screen.

Enter the code in the box on your laptop and your image will appear.



To disconnect, press the Windows Key and P to bring up Projection Options. Select Disconnect.
