**Hood:** The FCC Human Services Area of Concentration satisfies all lower level core requirements at Hood, including the FCC Gen Ed Math. If students take MATH 120 they will still need to take SOC 261 (Social Statistics) at Hood. Students who transfer to Hood College with a completed A.A. will have met Hood's lower level general education core requirements, and will not need to take World Languages, but students who transfer early should use electives credits to take World Languages 101 and 102 at FCC.

**Salisbury:** Students must apply to the BASW program – Requirements: 60 credits, Statistics (MATH 120), General Psychology (PSYC 101), ANTH 101 or ECON 201 or SOCY 101, 2.5 overall GPA, 2.7 in Social Work courses (HUMS 103).

Stevenson: Students can transfer up to 70 credits from FCC, although Federal Financial Aid will pay for only 60 credits toward the Human Services Associates Degree.

#### **Advising**

Students should meet with an advisor each semester to carefully select and sequence courses based on their PHED 165 specific academic goals and interests.

#### **Completing the Pathway**

Students who take fewer than 15 credits each semester or who require developmental English or math coursework will need additional semesters to complete their degrees. Summer and January term classes may help students to make faster progress.

General Education CORE courses can often be taken in any semester. One course must be designated as a Cultural Competence course. A minimum of nine credits must be taken at the 200 level. Refer to the college catalog (<u>frederick.edu/class-schedules</u>) for course details and the list of General Education and Cultural Competence classes.

#### **Reverse Transfer**

FCC students who transfer to another school may transfer credits *back to FCC* from that school to fulfill FCC associate degree requirements. Visit <u>frederick.edu/credit-admissions/reverse-transfer</u> or contact an advisor for more information.

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
