## **FCC Curriculum Pathway**

The Curriculum Pathway provides full-time students with a suggested quide for completing an Associate Degree in two years (four semesters). Students who choose to take less than 15 credits per semester or who require Developmental English and/or Math will need additional semesters to complete their degrees. Taking classes in the summer and/or January terms allow students to catch up and stay on target. It is recommended all students meet with an Advisor each semester to carefully select and sequence courses based on their specific interests and needs. Using the Curriculum Pathway along with the PeopleSoft Degree Plan allows students to track their progress towards graduation.
