FCC Curriculum Pathway

This Curriculum Pathway provides full-time students with a suggested guide for completing an Associate of Applied Sciences in Early Childhood Development in two years (four semesters). A grade of "C" or better must be earned in all ED and ECD courses. Students who choose to take less than 15 credits per semester or who require Developmental English and/or Math will need additional semesters to complete their degrees. Taking classes in the Summer and/or January terms allow students to catch up and stay on target. Using the Curriculum Pathway along with the PeopleSoft Degree Plan allows students to track their progress towards graduation.
