- 1. Apply to the College: Apply to FCC and declare Health Sciences: Pre-Surgical Technology AAS as your major.
- 2. Submit Official Transcripts: Send official college/university and high school transcripts, SAT & ACT scores as well as any CLEP, IB or AP scores to the Registration and Records Office.
  Note that official college/university transcripts should be sent upon application to FCC, and must be received by application date for Surgical Technology program
- 3. Apply for Financial Aid: Apply for Financial Assistance Submit the FAFSA and apply for scholarships.
- 4. Complete Placement Tests: Complete FCC placement tests as needed consult with Admissions or Advising.
- **5.** <u>Complete Pre-Admission Courses:</u> The following requirements **must** be completed with minimum grades of C **prior** to application to the Surgical Technology program:

ENGL101 (EN101) – English Composition

MATH – MATH120 Statistics or higher

COMM (CMSP) - General Education

Communications Elective

PSYC101 (PS101) – General Psychology OR

SOCY101 (SO101) – Introduction to Sociology

[Science prerequisite: BSCI55, BSCI150, or CHEM101]

BSCI201 (BI103) - Anatomy & Physiology I \*\*

The following requirements **can be in progress at the time of application** and must be completed with minimum grades of C <u>prior to starting the Surgical Technology program</u> (if admitted):

BSCI202 (BI104) - Anatomy & Physiology II\*\*

MEDA109\* (MDA109\*) <u>OR</u>

Up to 6-credits of electives\* (to total 28 credits of general education courses and free electives)

Terminology\*

As of January 1, 2025, Straighterline courses will no longer be accepted to satisfy pre-admission science requirements.

- 6. <u>Complete Job Shadowing</u>: Complete job shadowing with positive recommendation then submit verification form and 1-2 page Reflection Paper upon application for admission to the Surgical Technology. You will need to make your own arrangements for job shadowing experiences independently.

  - Submit PDF of verification form AND reflection paper as attachments to application to program.
- 7. Submit Application to the Surgical Technology Program: Submit the online application for the Surgical Technology Program once you have finished or are in progress with your final pre-admission courses as outlined above.

<sup>\*\*</sup> A+P courses taken more than 3 times in 5 years, including withdrawals, without a 'C' or better will not be considered. A+P courses cannot be older than 7 years.
