Transfer Application Checklist

• How to find transfer information on the College or University webpage?

 Go to the 4-Year school's admission webpage. When you are searching for the Admission Transfer Webpage, check for keywords such as Transfer Applicants, Transfer Student, Transfer Student Center, or Transfer Admission.

• Preparing for the Application Process

- Check to see if the webpage lists steps for the Transfer Application Process.
- You may notice that the school has its own application or that it accepts a universal application like the Coalition or Common Application.
- Is there a certain amount of credits needed to be considered a transfer student?
- Deadlines Matter! Know when to apply.
 - Find the school's application deadlines. Are you considering transferring in the Fall or Spring semester? When is the Fall application deadline? When is the Spring application deadline?
 - Does the school have a preferred, early action, or priority date? Does the school have a regular deadline date? Is there rolling admission?
- Application Fees. Find out how much it costs to apply.
- **Do you need to submit an essay?** The school may include an essay prompt on how to structure your response.
- Sending your Official Transcripts
 - Have official transcripts sent from every college or university you have attended.
 - You can request your FCC Official Transcript to be sent electronically through Parchment using the link below: <u>https://www.frederick.edu/current-students/transcript-</u> <u>services.aspx</u>
 - **NOTE!** Remember to send your official transcripts after your final grades are posted.
 - Check the school's website to determine where to send official transcripts.
 - Do you need to send official high school transcripts

• Special Documentation

- Do you need to send official standardized test scores such as SAT/ACT?
- Are there specific requirements needed for the major you are choosing? Does your major require a portfolio? Is there a specific course or GPA needed to be accepted to the program?
- Are Letters of Recommendation required for the application?
